Registration, all rehearsals, and performance will happen in this ballroom.

Who:

Donna L. Kinsey - Event Chair and Festival Clinician

Helen Mondi - Local Coordinator from the Cincinnati Archdiocese.

Ringers - Handbell choirs, partial handbell choirs, as well as individual ringers (aka orphans) from all over the U.S. who have rehearsed and learned the Festival repertoire.

How:

Complete the registration form and return with registration fee to NPM. After your registration has been received it will be forwarded to me (Donna Kinsey). I will send you rehearsal notes, bell assignments for orphan ringers, a schedule when it is finalized, and information about handbell set up in Junior Ballroom.

In order to facilitate acceptances for choirs, partial choirs, and orphan ringers (ringers that are coming without a choir but who have prepared the repertoire on assigned bells) NPM will accept registrations on a first-come, first-served basis, so please register as early as possible.

Completed applications should be postmarked by April 28, 2017

I will email confirmation of acceptance after your registration form and fees have been processed by the NPM office.

Once you've registered for the Festival, please remember that housing and meals are to be arranged by the participants. If you plan to stay for the convention beyond Monday evening you'll need to register for additional days or the full conference. Please visit the NPM website (www.npm.org) in January for housing information and/or a convention registration form. There are hotels close to the convention center, and many restaurants and local attractions are within walking distance. NPM is working on college dorm housing but preparations are not yet completed.

All ringers under 18 years of age must follow The Code of Conduct for Youth Participating in NPM Conventions. The Code (which includes 3 parts to be signed by the youth, the chaperone, and the parent/guardian) will be online at www.npm.org when full convention details are posted in January. You must submit your forms to me when you register at the Festival on Saturday morning or you cannot be admitted to participate in the Festival.

What to wear:

For the performance on Monday evening, choirs/ringers are asked to wear a "dress up" black top and black pants or skirt. Men may wear ties- black or the color of their choosing.

Convention Badges/Name Tags: All ringers receive Handbell Festival badges, which will serve as admission to the Convention and Exhibits on the opening day of the Convention, Monday, July 10th only. Please wear at all times. A full convention schedule will be online at www.npm.org in

January. We encourage as many as can to attend the full conference. Handbell sessions will be part of the convention.

Music:

You should purchase your music (see enclosed repertoire list) and begin rehearsals as soon as possible so that all ringers will be very confident of their parts. There are several pieces included that have been part of past Festivals. Jeffers Handbell Supply offers a discount for all music ordered through them.

What to bring:

Local directors are to assign bell positions for ringers in their bell choirs. Unless you speak to me in advance, you'll be expected to bring your handbells, foam pads, table covering, mallets, music in an easel folder, risers (if you use them), and gloves. Tables will be provided but you may bring your own if you choose. If you are an orphan ringer I will assign your bells.

Orphan Ringers:

If you have an opening in your choir where an **orphan ringer** would be welcome, please let me know. I will assign orphan ringers to a handbell position and choir. Orphan ringers are asked to prepare their music before they arrive in Cincinnati. You'll be given contact info for your new choir so you can touch base before the festival if you like. I will work out all assignments as soon as I receive registrations from the various choirs or, if there is a sufficient number of orphan ringers, create a choir just for them. In some years there have been as few as 4 orphan ringers and, in other years, over 20 orphan ringers.

Our local coordinator this year is Helen Mondi. Many thanks to Helen for volunteering to help us!!!! It is wonderful to have someone who knows the area and is a handbell ringer and director that will act as our local coordinator!
