Rite of Marriage

The consent and exchange of rings were followed by rituals from the Filipino tradition. The bride and groom were presented with coins to symbolize hope for prosperity and commitment to generous and total giving of self. They were then covered with a white veil, symbolizing the purity of married love, and a cord was placed around them as a sign that they are now bound in an intimate union—one in mind, heart, and affection.
