

V. Lift up your hearts. R. We lift them up to the Lord.




V. Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. R. It is right and just.

signs and wonders a new Bap-tism, so that through the voice




that came down from heav-en we might come to be-lieve in your

likeness of a dove we might know that Christ your Servant




has been anointed with the oil of glad-ness and sent to bring
