The Basic Cantor Certificate is the first stage in the NPM Cantor Certificate program, recognizing the achievement of the *fundamental* skills expected of cantors.

All certificate levels presume an understanding of the spirituality of this important ministry.

NPM Basic Cantor Certificate Requirements

Test Process

The test for the Basic Cantor Certificate has two components (vocal and written). *Each* component must have a passing score of 70%.

1. Vocal Adjudication
 - Two responsorial psalms **from the approved list** (below)—one setting chosen from List A (Chant) and one chosen from List B (Melodic);
 - A setting of the *Kyrie*
 - A setting of the *Lamb of God*
 - Pitch Matching and Intervals - The candidate will be asked to sing three series of three pitches played on the piano.
2. Musical and Liturgical Knowledge: By written exam, the candidate will demonstrate familiarity with:
 - Basic musical notation
 - The *Order of Mass*
 - Multiple choice questions based on paragraphs 8-40 of *Sing to the Lord: Music in Divine Worship*
 - How a cantor is expected to prepare to proclaim the psalm.

Application Process

Eligibility

All members of NPM are eligible to apply for the NPM Basic Cantor Certificate. Non-members may apply for membership when applying for the certificate.

Procedures

1. Complete the application form and return it with a non-refundable \$25 (members) or \$64 (non-members) processing fee to NPM-BCC, P.O. Box 224121, Chantilly, VA 20153-4121.
2. Upon receipt of your application and payment of fee, you will be contacted by a member of the Cantor Certificate Committee who will provide further instructions.
3. All adjudications (live or recorded) and exams must be completed within one year of the date on which your application is received.

Mass Settings (For *Kyrie* and *Lamb of God* selections)

BCC applicants may use a Mass setting of their choice, under these conditions:

- The Mass setting must conform to the text of the *Roman Missal*, third edition, or its Spanish equivalent
 - The Mass setting must be published and easily accessible through a major publisher of liturgical music.
- Selections are subject to approval of the Certificate Administrator.
