*For the Love of God: What Makes Music Suitable for Liturgy*

Using AGAPE as an acronym, we will explore the concept that music must be artistic, genuine, authentic, purposeful, and evangelizing in order that it may be not only appropriate, but effective, for worship. The session will delve into creative ways to meet these criteria and include concrete examples of how this approach is actualized at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC. Dr. Latona will place a particular focus on how the AGAPE approach can be realized in any parish music program, giving participants the inspiration and tools to strive for this ideal.

*Spontaneous Beauty: Creating Music for the Liturgy*

Part of our vocation is to use improvisation and composition to enhance the beauty of the Liturgy. A clear approach to these two pillars of liturgical music, as well as multiple techniques, will be offered, with the objective of giving participants the tools necessary for achieving immediate results. Forms such as psalm antiphons, psalm tones, propers, acclamations, descants, etc., will be discussed and demonstrated.

Recognized as a conductor, composer, organist, improviser, and teacher, he is dedicated to providing the highest standard in sacred music within the context of the Roman Catholic Liturgy. An award-winning organist, Dr. Latona has performed throughout the United States, Europe, and the Holy Land.

Dr. Latona is a graduate of Bucknell University (B. Mus.), the Yale School of Music (M. Mus.), and the Manhattan School of Music (D.M.A.).

### Description

Situated in vibrant Crystal City, one mile from Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport, Holiday Inn offers an ideal location close to all that Washington, DC has to offer.

### Registration Fees

Registration fees include all *Colloquium* sessions, materials, opening evening cocktail reception, Tuesday and Wednesday breakfast and lunch, as well as transportation to and from the Basilica for sessions on Wednesday. Note that for “Registration including Hotel”:

- Please specify which nights you will be staying at the Holiday Inn National Airport. All rooms are single occupancy. *Reservations will be made by NPM within our designated room block.*
- Registration does not include parking fees; a discounted overnight parking rate of \$18 is being made available to *Colloquium* attendees.
- An additional “Facilities Fee” is required for non-Commuter attendees who choose alternate accommodations, or who stay at the designated hotel fewer than two nights. This fee will help to offset the additional costs that NPM will incur based on our commitments related to the contract with the hotel (*room block minimums and meeting room rental*).

### Check-in and Check-out

Check-in is available beginning at 4:00 PM. Early check-in may be requested, but is granted on a “space available” basis and is *not* guaranteed. Check-out is 12 Noon; individuals staying in their rooms beyond 12 NOON will be billed one additional night’s stay unless late check-out arrangements have been made in advance. Late check-out is provided based on availability although some charges may apply. Arrangements can be made by contacting the front desk. Luggage storage is available for early arrivals and/or late departures.

### Transportation

The hotel offers a complimentary shuttle from Reagan National Airport. The shuttle stops for drop off and pick up at the designated Hotel Shuttle pick-up areas. Watch for the National Airport Holiday Inn shuttle which has large red logos for their on-site restaurant, Fresh Kitchen, to easily identify them.

### Hotel Amenities

The hotel offers a Fitness Center, 24-hour Business Center with fax, copier and printer access, O’Malley’s Pub (on-site), Room Service, and an on-site covered parking garage (\$10 daily/\$18 overnight) with unlimited in/out privileges.

### Cancellation Policy
