NPM Basic Pianist Certificate Requirements

TEST PROCESS

The test for the Basic Pianist Certificate has two components:

1. **Service Music:** Each candidate must play from the approved list (on the following page)
 - Two hymns—one based on a Metrical Hymn Tune and one Contemporary Liturgical Song
 - A Responsorial Psalm
 - A setting of the Eucharistic Prayer Acclamations (Holy, Holy, Holy/ Memorial Acclamation response/Great Amen)
 - A setting of the Lamb of God/Agnus Dei

All hymns, psalms and service music selections are to be chosen from the Examination Repertoire List below and online.

2. **Piano Literature:** Each candidate must also play two pieces of his or her own choosing which are to be selected from the NPM Liturgical Piano Repertoire list. The list is available online at <https://npm.org/wp-content/uploads/Piano-Certification-Repertoire-Liturgical.pdf>.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Eligibility

All active members of NPM are eligible to apply for the NPM Basic Pianist Certificate.

Procedures

1. Complete the application form and return it with a non-refundable \$25 processing fee to NPM-BPC, 962 Wayne Avenue, Suite 550, Silver Spring, MD 20910-4461.
2. Upon receipt of your application and payment of fee, you will be contacted by a member of the BPC Examination Committee and will be given instructions for selecting a proctor and completing a recording of your chosen repertoire.
3. In the presence of the assigned proctor, record your chosen repertoire digitally. The proctor signs an affidavit as witness.
4. Submit two copies of your recording to the e-mail address given to you by the Examination Committee. You will be notified of the results. *All recordings must be submitted within one year of the date on which your application is received.*

EXPECTATIONS

Adjudicators will be looking for the basic skills needed for accompanying a congregation: accuracy of notes and rhythms, steady and appropriate *tempi*, clear introductions, and basic piano technique.
