## **Liturgical Music Intensive** ***Spiritual Formation, Music Ministry, and the Psalms***

**JANUARY 17 - FEBRUARY 15, 2022**

This 4-week, online intensive links Scripture--particularly the Psalms--and music ministry with spiritual formation. This course is designed for liturgical musicians, especially cantors and music directors. It focuses on how prayer and Scripture form and guides them, their ministry, and the gathered ecclesial community.

The course includes spiritual formation and:

- Addresses the spirituality of Scripture, the Lectionary, and the Psalms
- Draws out pastoral implications for music ministers and the gathered community
- Can contribute to the fulfillment of ICC and CCC levels of NPM Cantor Certification requirements
- Is fully online and asynchronous (done at your own pace with virtual dialogue sessions)
- Includes optional weekly live class meetings
- Is eligible for certificate, undergraduate, or graduate credit


**Instructors:**

- Dr. Dan Girardot, D.Min. Associate Director, Office of Worship, Archdiocese of Galveston Houston and adjunct professor of liturgy, music, and spiritual formation.
- Dr. Tom Ryan, Ph.D. writes and presents on the history of spirituality and biblical interpretation

**Loyola Credit Options:**

- You can take the course for 1 CEU credit. It requires reading and viewing assigned material and participating in discussions. The cost for 1 CEU credit is \$135, and it can be combined with other CEU credits for a CEU certificate.
- You can also take the course for 1 undergraduate credit or 1 graduate credit. In addition to CEU requirements, these credits also require you to work with faculty on university-level research and reflection assignments that can contribute to the fulfillment of ICC and CCC levels of NPM Cantor Certification requirements. The cost for 1 undergraduate credit is \$450 for tuition and \$112.50 tech fees. The cost for 1 graduate credit is \$405 for tuition and \$112.50 for tech fees. These credits can be combined with other credits for a graduate or undergraduate degree or certificate.
- All credits will be available on an official Loyola transcript. Electronic certificate of completion is also available upon request.
